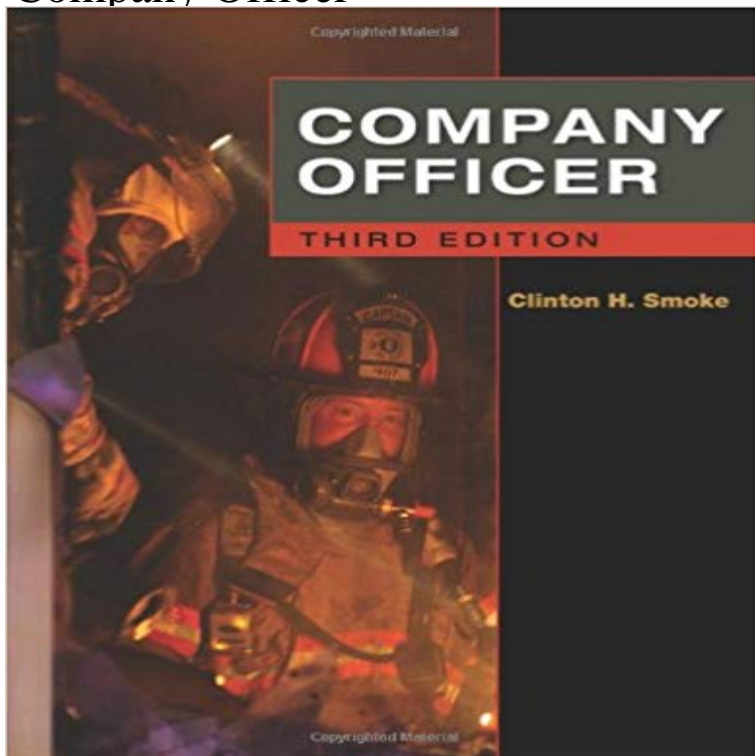


Company Officer
