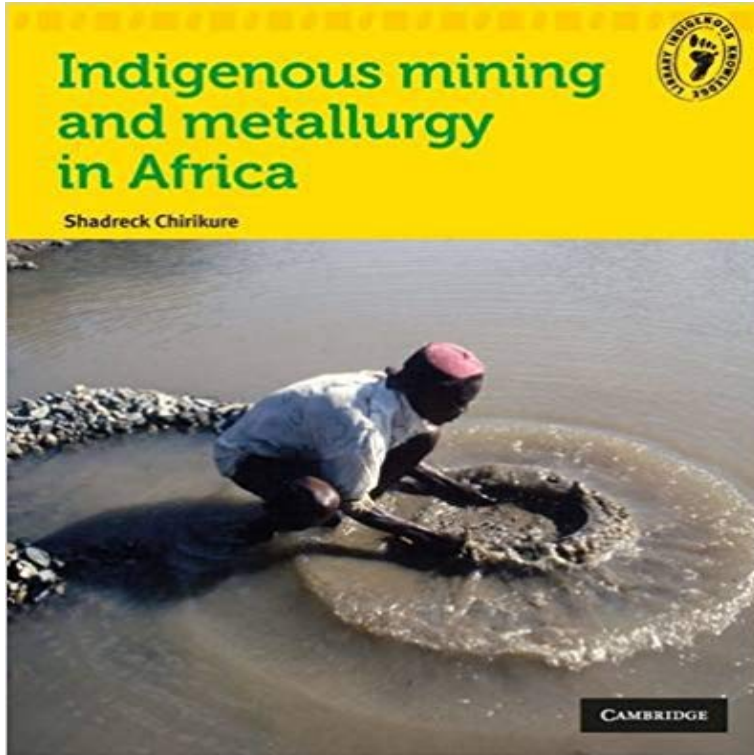


Indigenous Knowledge Library: Indigenous Mining and Metallurgy in Africa
