


## The Turacos



The Turacos (1860) Many rare and beautiful historical books are safely tucked away in safes and climatized rooms of libraries. ETI with support of NBBi republished some of these books electronically to enhance accessibility and use on computers and mobile devices. The Turacos by Gerard Frederik Westerman (1807-1890) and Hermann Schlegel (1804-1884) is an extremely rare publication of the Royal Zoological Society Natura Artis Magistra, dedicated to His Majesty The King. It ranks among the finest bird books ever published. The original Dutch publication in elephant folio (format 57 x 72 cm) was produced in a very limited edition and never for sale. Florence F.J.M. Pieters M. Sc., curator of the Artis Library at the University of Amsterdam supervised the digitization of this fine work which is now available as an eBook.
