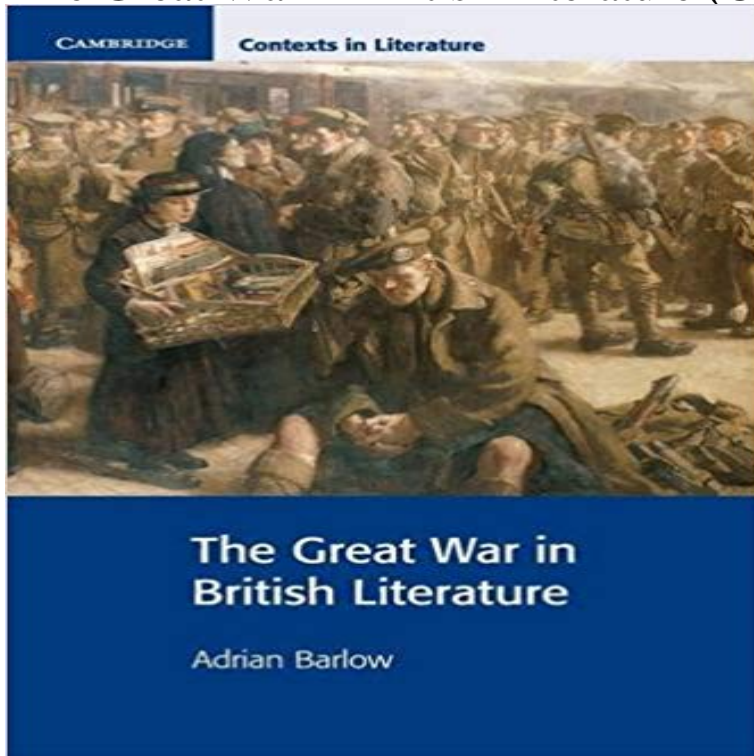


The Great War in British Literature (Cambridge Contexts in Literature)
