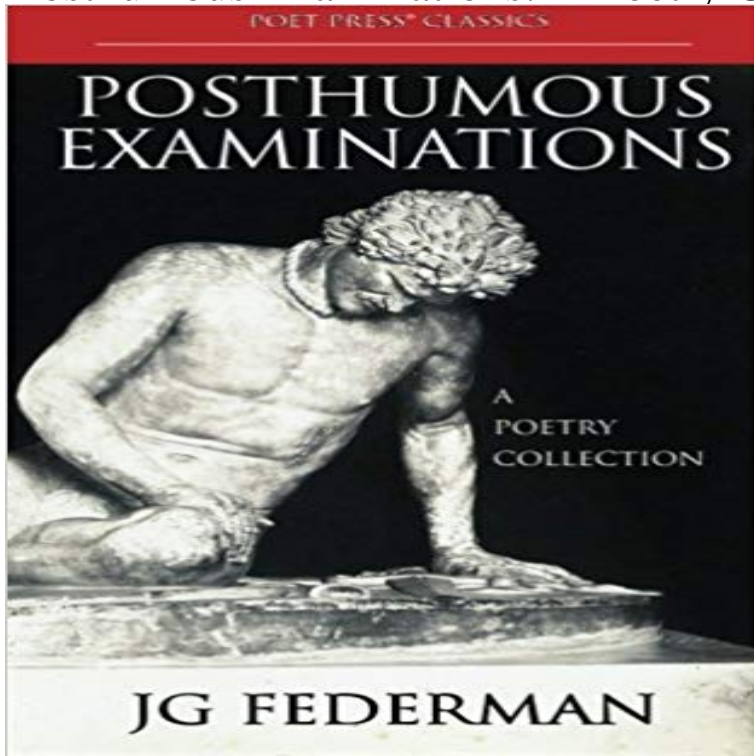


Posthumous Examinations: A Poetry Collection
