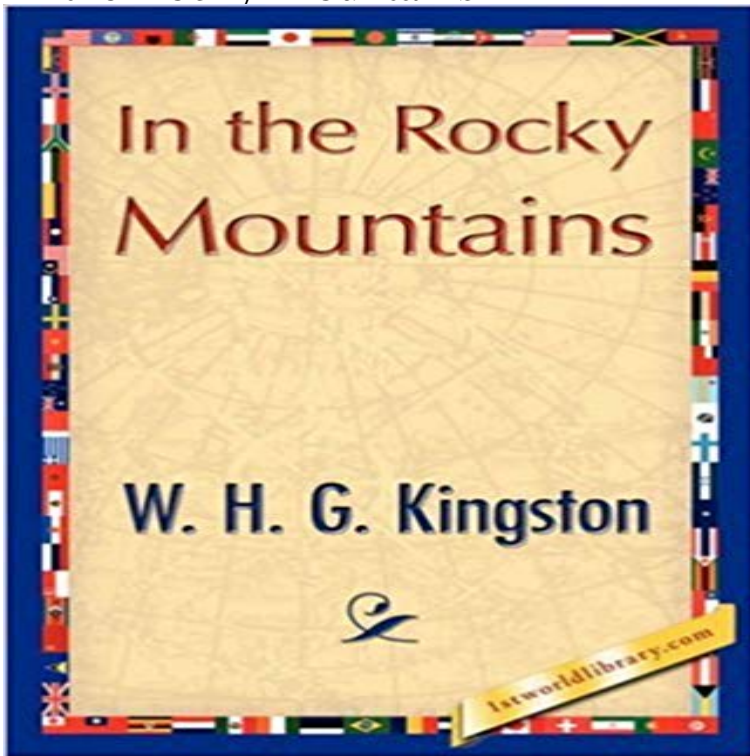


In the Rocky Mountains
