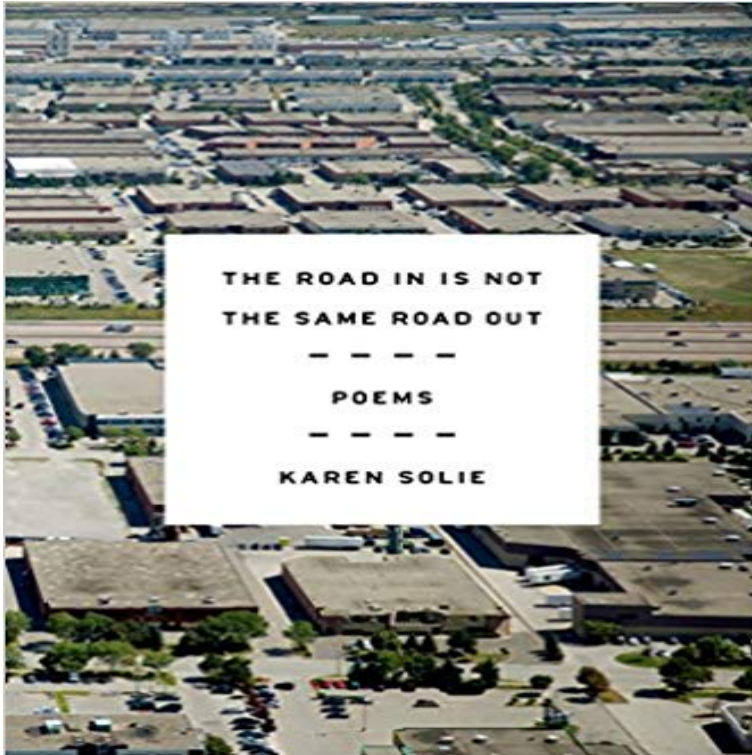


## The Road In Is Not the Same Road Out: Poems
